Unique hand made silk Persian rugs scattered on the smoked oak floor embellish the warm and luxurious décor. Herbeau from France, Pompadour collection bathroom accessories featuring Gargoyle faucets reign on hand made carved pewter counter tops.

Finest Sferra Italian linen, Canadian white duck hypoallergenic duvets and pillows, ultra soft pearl Minky dots velvet bed covers with a multitude of well stuffed assorted cushions, "Super Pile" thick bath drape and towels Collection by Abyss and Sferra Italian bathrobes have been meticulously selected to guarantee the finest luxurious comfort.

To complete in style, each stateroom has his personalized padded headboard covered with thematic "sea to sky" fabric; a wink on Absinthe's ability to explore the world from the ocean as well as from the air with the helicopter. Inspired by the famous Metamorphosis by M.C. Escher, each headboard represents an element coming from the sea gradually metamorphosing into a flying creature.

Puiforcat silver flat ware, Bernardaud Limoges fine porcelain and Riedel crystal glasses are delicately aligned, protected by velvet covered custom made drawers and cabinets.

The dining room opens to the bar with sliding French doors.

· BAR, finished with light sand accent wood paneling, L shaped lit counter bar topped with yellow travertine marble, curvy shape sink, Carousel design lounge chairs, asymmetric love seats and work of art coffee tables give this salon a real trendy feeling. An invitation for an entertaining evening with all the practical storage including large capacity refrigerator, extensive custom made cabinet displays for alcohol decanters and cabinets for glasses. A 37" (94cm) Sharp Aquos LCD flat screen TV is on forward wall.

Doors lead out to the aft deck intimate lounge.

· AFT DECK with intimate comfortable seating area around coffee table with another moveable wireless 22" (45cm) Sharp Aquos LCD TV screen, an outdoor gym with stationary exercisers and two staircase going up to the upper deck.

Wheelhouse

Smoked oak hardwood floor, herring bone pattern oak deck head, bulkheads covered with bright red Tabu bird's eye maple paneling. Console, chart table, desk, and cabinets hand milled from solid oak, carefully detailed with touches of gold and lightly padded with Italian black leather on top. High-tech black and stainless steel adjustable captain's chair with a similar double one for the guests as well as a majestic antique hand carved throne provide comfortable seating in this warm and appealing wheelhouse. Forward facing with double insulated tempered glass to reduce heat and prevent fogging. Access by staircase coming from the crew dining area and the library plus starboard and port direct access doors.

Crew Quarters

The 2003/2005 refit included a complete remodeling of the crew quarters. The cabins comfortably accommodate 19 crew in 11 cabins. Included in the crew area is a crew dining area, crew lounge, and crew office. The crew quarters have been afforded the same level of care the passenger cabins have received.

The crew area is decorated in a very modern refreshing style, a rich blend of vivid colors, stainless steel accents, brushed aluminum tables, marine blue simili leather covered benches and natural wood cabinetries. Smoked oak hardwood flooring was laid in the common areas; carpeting was put down in the crew cabins and anti-skid commercial marine blue 2"x2" tiling in the crew dining and the laundry.
